

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING IMMUNIZATIONS

YUKON HOSPITAL CORPORATION VOLUNTEER SERVICES

Thank you for applying to volunteer with the Yukon Hospital Corporation at Whitehorse General Hospital!

YHC (Volunteer Services) requires that you undergo screening for Tuberculosis and update your required immunizations.

As per hospital policy (*Communicable Disease OHS 060*), we require specifically that your MMR (Measles, Mumps & Rubella) & TDAP (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) and Varicella immunizations are updated or deemed immune per the vaccine program. Depending on your country of origin, you may require other immunization updates

This can be completed at WGH with Samantha Stewart (867-393-8933), or at the Whitehorse Health Centre (please phone to make an appointment 867-667-8864). The Health Nurse will review your immunization history and go over your needs with you, including documentation to verify that you have been recently screened for TB. Prior to your first day as a volunteer, please visit your local Health Center to verify that all of your immunizations are up to date.

**Please ask your health care provider to complete the chart below and return to me prior to your first day as a volunteer. If you are from out of the Territory, or are unable to access your immunization history, you will need to speak to your health care provider about obtaining these records. This can be done with assistance from Samantha Stewart (WGH) or at the Whitehorse Health Center.
