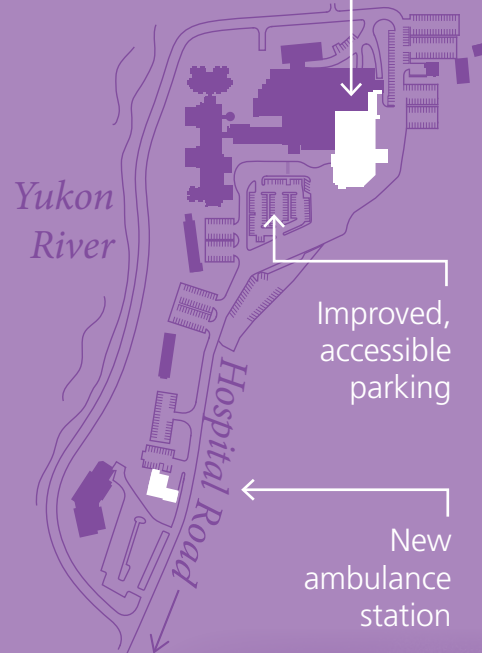


## Whitehorse General Hospital Expansion Know where to go

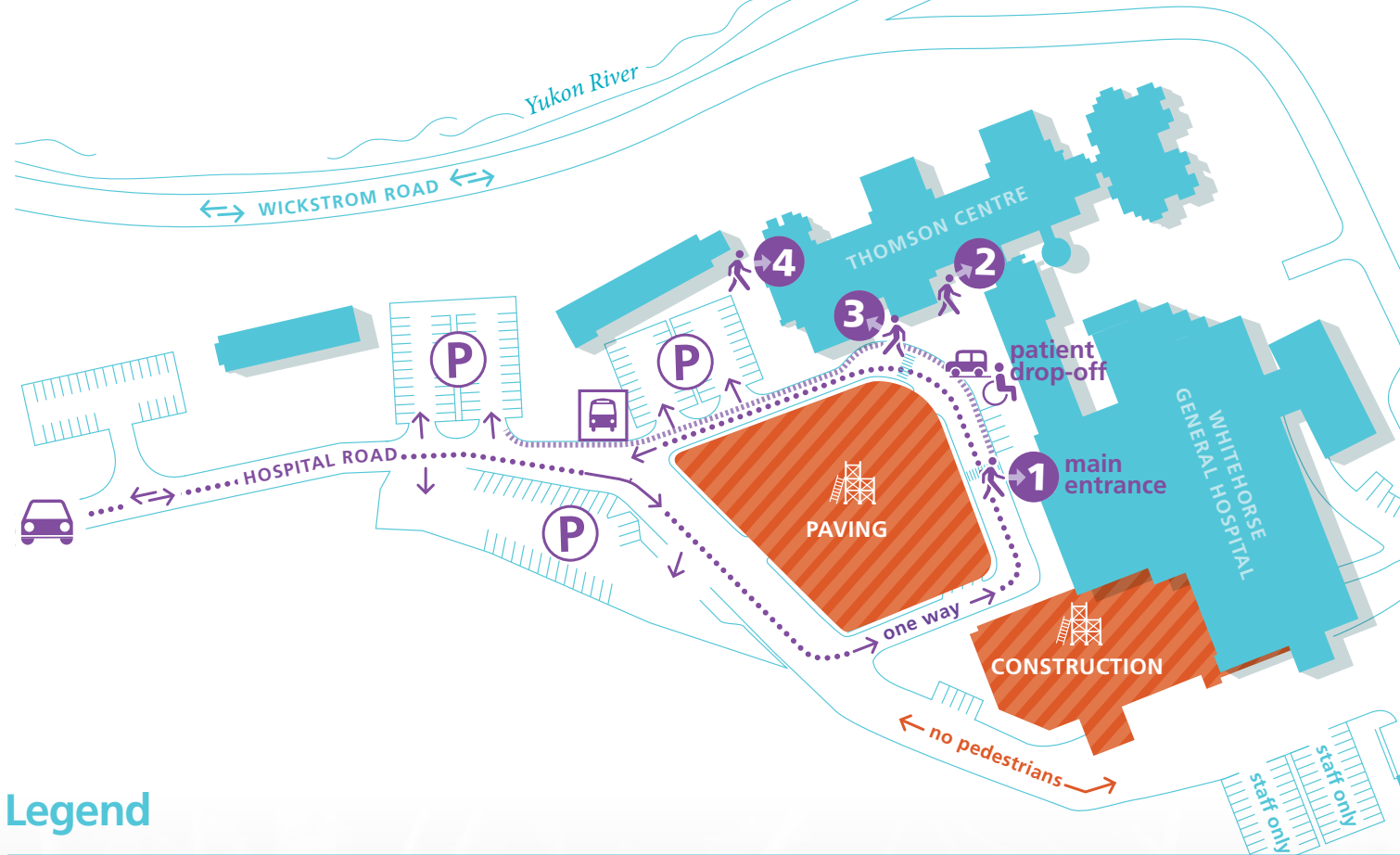

- Use patient drop-off and designated parking spaces for individuals with disabilities located at front of the hospital
